

## **COURSE FEEDBACK**

The college is affiliated to university of Mumbai, hence has to implement the syllabus in all subjects as prescribed by the bond of studies. There is very little scope or freedom for modification of the syllabus. But the college has a practice of taking feedback about the syllabus from the students to check the effectively of the syllabus. Being thought. This feedback is usually conducted by the class teachers, after explaining the purpose to students. Clearly stating that it is the feedback of the course contents and not about teachers or methodology of teaching the same. The feedback is kept short of not more than ten questions and giving students' ample scope of grading from 1 to 9. The feedback covers various aspects regarding the syllabus like learning value, applicability, depth of content, efforts required by students, relevance etc. the feedback received from the students is then analyzed and inference drawn by the HOD's who in turn convey them to the university of Mumbai Board of study members as suggestions for future revision of syllabus. But as stated earlier the difference made is negligible since we are just one of the 100 college affiliated to university. But at our college end, we take efforts to reduce the efforts required by the students and help them overcome the hindrance towards better understanding and application of the course contents.
