




6. Coivd Care Immunity Booster for Students :

7. Webinar on Voter ID registration by APNSS






10. BSE Crash Course



Total 30 NSS volunteers, including 17 boys and 13 girls, participated in the activity under the supervision of NSS Joint secretary Kajal Varma.












22. Plastic waste management- Waste collection and submission :




24. Online exam information and precaution video:







30. Session on mental health by Mpower session on




37. Tribute to Martyers on Shahid Divas
