

The meeting started with recitation of a verse from Quran by Prof. Mohd. Arif.

Prof. Dr. Shaukat Ali, Principal extended a warm welcome to all the members present for CDC meeting. Leave of absence was granted to Mr. Shagaf Nakid, Mr. Ashrafali Kalsekar, Mr. Farid Shaikh and Dr. Sirajuddin Chougle.

The following agenda was discussed:

Item No.1: To read and confirm minutes of the last meeting held on 18-09-2021 (circulated).

The Minutes of the last meeting held on 18th Sep. 2021 were read and confirmed by all the members.

Item No.2: To discuss the results of the College for the academic year 2021-22 and admissions for the year 2022-23.

Principal Dr. Shaukat Ali presented the analysis of the Examination results of all the courses for the academic year 2021-22. He informed the house about the results as under;

HSC - 75.84%, TY.B.Com. - 88.46%, M.Com. - 88.24%

TY.BMS - 100%, TY.BMM - 100%, TY.B.Sc.(CS) - 100%, TY.B.Sc.(IT) - 100%, M.Sc.(IT) - 100%

Mrs. Yasmin Saifullah, Chairperson applauded the results and praised the efforts of all the staff of the College and congratulated them.

Prof. Sameer Naik, Chairman-Exam. Committee presented the further analysis of the Examination results. Mrs. Yasmin Saifullah praised the fact that there are more of First Class and second class students and only a few passed in pass class. She praised that there is tremendous qualitative enhancement in the results of all the courses of the College.

Prof. Sameer Naik informed the members present that due to Covid, all exams were conducted online. During this period, the Exam Committee with help of IT Cell was able to conduct the exams within a very small budget (Rs.50,000/- per session) as compared to other Colleges who invested heavily (Rs.3 to 5 Lakhs) in exam softwares.

Prof. Sameer Naik requested to make provision for an advance amount for managing daily expenses in conduct of examination and also other committees like NSS, etc.

Principal Dr. Shaukat Ali informed about the ongoing admissions for the academic year 2022-23. He informed the house that admission status is very good. Even for few courses, we took additional seats from University of Mumbai and those seats are also full.

Item No.3: To inform about the achievements/activities conducted and plans for the year 2022-23.

 Principal Dr. Shaukat Ali informed that the following four new courses have been started by the College from the academic year 2022-23;

Graduation courses:

- 1) B.A.F. (Accts. & Finance)
- 2) B.Com. (Travel & Tourism)
- 3) B.Sc. (Data Science)

Post-Graduation course:

4) M.Com. (Business Management)

The Chairperson applauded that the College has become multi-disciplinary institution.

- 2) Principal also informed that few teachers of our College have been awarded Ph.D. Degree viz. Prof. M. H. Lakdawala, Prof. Kirtikumar Pimpliskar, Prof. B. Karbhari, etc. and some teachers have applied to become Ph.D. Guide and few more teachers have enrolled themselves for Ph.D. Prof. Smita Salunke has also completed a minor research project. These achievements are helpful for NAAC.
- 3) Principal informed about the curricular and other activities conducted for the academic year 2022-23. He informed that Skill Oriented courses like Hardware and Networking has also been started in the College.
