Copy of the proceedings in the matter of an application No.4/1/320, dated 30th August, 1982, from the Principal, Akbar Peerbhoy College of Commerce and Economics, Byculla, Bombay, for the permanent affiliation of the college for the teaching of the courses of study for the B.Com. degree examination.

On receipt of the application the Executive Council appointed a local inquiry committee consisting of the following members to report thereon :-

Prof. M.V. Chandgadkar
Prof. S.V. Kale
Prin. M.D. Limaye

The report of the local inquiry committee was considered by the Academic Council and the Executive Council at their meetings held on 10th July, 1984 and 28th July, 1984, respectively.

The resolution of the Academic Council and the report of the Executive Council are as follows :-

Resolution of the Academic Council

It was resolved that it be reported to the Executive Council that, in the opinion of the Council, the affiliation of the Akbar Peerbhoy College of Commerce and Economics, Byculla, Bombay, to the University for the teaching of the courses of study for the B.Com. degree examination in the following subjects be made permanent with retrospective effect from 16th June, 1983. :-

(The subjects are the same as those mentioned in the above Senate resolution.)

Resolved further that it be recommended to the Executive Council that the college be permitted to have, on a permanent basis, 6 divisions of F.Y. B.Com. class and that any additional division, if found necessary, be opened with the prior approval of the University.

Report of the Executive Council

The Executive Council, after considering the report of the local inquiry committee and the resolution of the Academic Council thereon, report to the Senate that it is of the opinion that the affiliation of the Akbar Peerbhoy College of Commerce and Economics, Byculla, Bombay, to the University for the teaching of the courses of study for the B.Com. degree examination in the following subjects, be made permanent with retrospective effect from 16th June, 1983 :-

(The subjects are the same as those mentioned in the above Senate resolution.)



At their meeting held on 15th & 16th January, 1985, the Senate considered the above application together with the report of the local inquiry committee, the resolution of the Academic Council thereon and the report of the Executive Council in the matter.

Professor G.L. Abhyankar moved, as recommended by the Executive Council, and Dr. S.N. Deshmukh seconded -

"That the Senate approve of the report of the Executive Council in the matter of the permanent affiliation of the Akbar Peerbhoy College of Commerce and Economics, Byculla, Bombay, and record their opinion that the affiliation of the college to the University for the teaching of the courses of study for the B.Com. degree examination in the following subjects be made permanent with retrospective effect from 16th June, 1983 :-

- (1) Following Disciplinary (Compulsory) subjects at F.Y. and S.Y.- B.Com.—Accounting and Financial Management;
- (2) Following Special subject at the T.Y.B.Com.—Accounting and Auditing;
- (3) Following Ancillary subjects—Industrial Psychology and Economic Systems ;
- (4) Following subjects under the Applied Component Group—Export Management, Advertising, Mass Communication, Computer System, Regulation of Trade Practices and Management of Small Scale Industry.

Shri Jamsaheb S. Mukadam moved the following amendment which stood in his name, and Shri S.A. Modak seconded :-

Add the following at the end of the motion :-

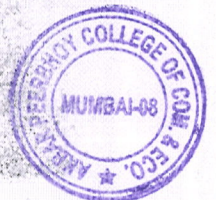
"Subject to the fulfilment of the condition that the college authorities give an undertaking in writing that they shall provide quarters for the Principal latest by the end of December, 1985."

M. Com

1. Enroll not more than 60 students at M.Com. Part- I in every academic year and take the prior permission of the University for any increase in number of seats above 60 students.
2. Give an undertaking that the College Management shall make adequate funds available for successful implementation of M.Com. Degree Course.
3. Spend Rs. 7,000/- each in 2004-05 & 2005-06 to purchase the Text / Reference books prescribed in M.Com. syllabus.
4. Spend Rs. 10,000/- each in 2004-05 & 2005-06 to subscribe to the academic journals related to Commerce faculty.
5. Make separate provisions for classrooms to the M.Com. students.
6. Charge the fees to the students as prescribed by the University of Mumbai.
7. Submit an undertaking from the teaching staff for voluntarily participating in M.Com. teaching programme and make their services available for conducting University examinations whenever required.
8. Encourage the eligible teaching staff to apply to the University for recognition as P.G. teachers in Commerce / E-Commerce.
9. Make separate seating arrangement for M.Com students in the reading hall of the library.
10. Take initiative in sponsoring the teaching staff to participate in various workshops / Seminars / Symposia / Conferences & to take membership in some professional bodies like institute of Chartered Accountant, Institute of Cost Association, Indian Chamber of Commerce etc.
