

Principal's Message.....





TREE PLANTATION PROGRAMME



TREE PLANTATION PROGRAMME at our adopted village Komalwadi








PEACE RALLY








Ganesh Immersion Crowd Control Duty at Nagapada Junction








BLOOD DONATION CAMP









Teacher's Day Celebration









Celebration of Constitution Day in College Campus






WORKSHOP in BHAVAN's College












ROAD SAFETY PROGRAMME AT YashwantraoChavhan Centre, Mantralaya, Mumbai






GLOBAL HOSPITAL RALLY on WORLD STROKE DAY

To create awareness about the stroke among the people Global hospital under CSR has organised an awareness rally and interactive session with students .Our College NSS Volunteers participated in it.








Session on Drug ABUSE at Siddhartha College (Aanad Bhavan)

Poster Making Competition



The inauguration of camp by the Principal Prof.Mohd.Tahir and Ms. Sandhya Deosthali, President of Kotwalwadi Trust,Neral enlightened the volunteers for social work and Clean India campaign i.e.'Swachcha Bharat Abhiyaan"

The first day Ms. Sandhya Deosthali, in charge of camp introduced with brief history of and instructed

about the work. We all volunteer get together at one place and started our work.

29 volunteers and 1 Programme officer participated in 7 daySpecial Camp held at Komalwadi from 15th January 2019to21st January 2019 .Various programmes were held for the personality development of the volunteers. Our students actively participated in 'Shramadan' during the camp.

Camp began with the survey of kombalwadi, the theme of the camp was "SWACHCHA BHARAT ABHIYAAN".
