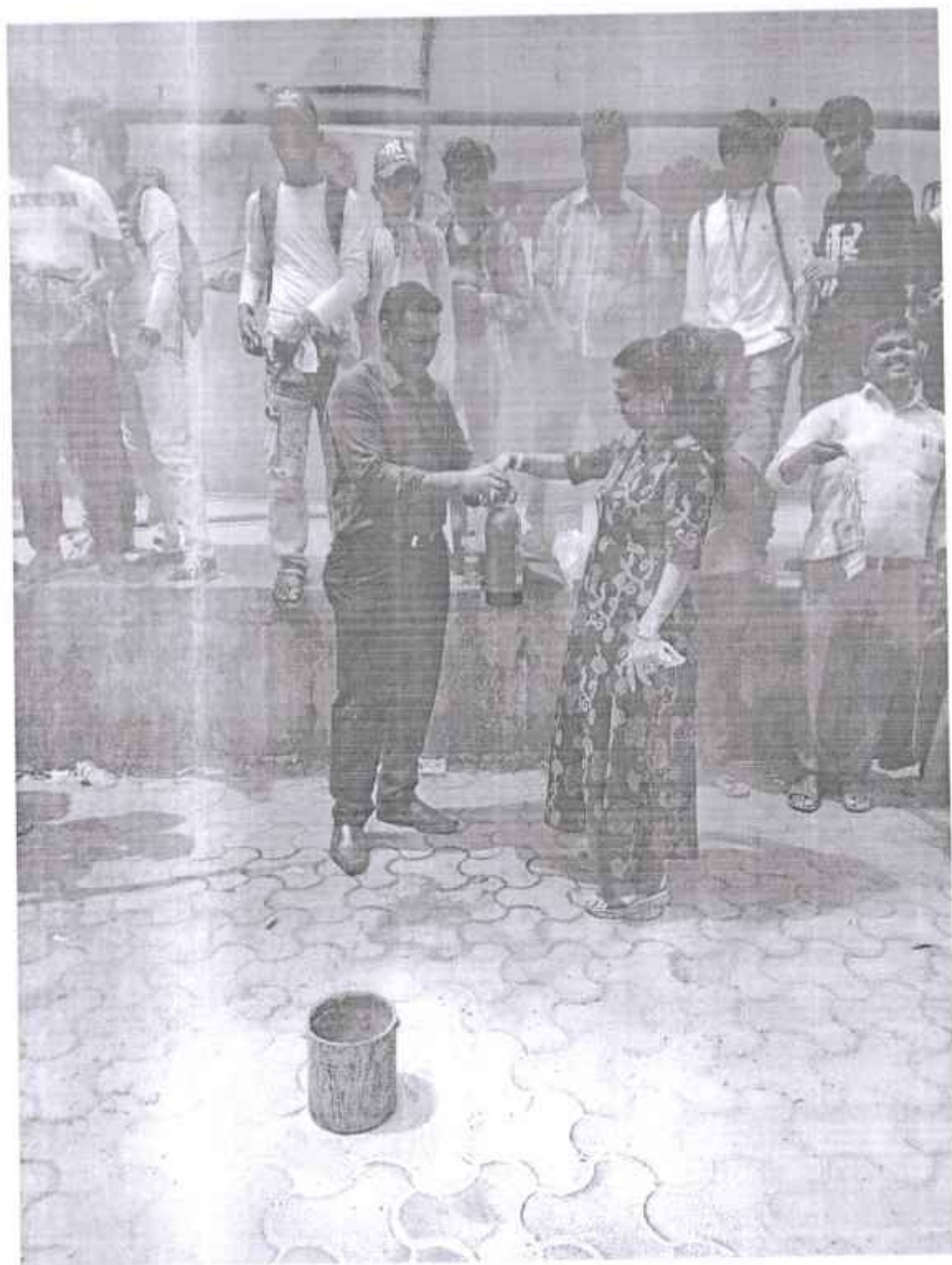


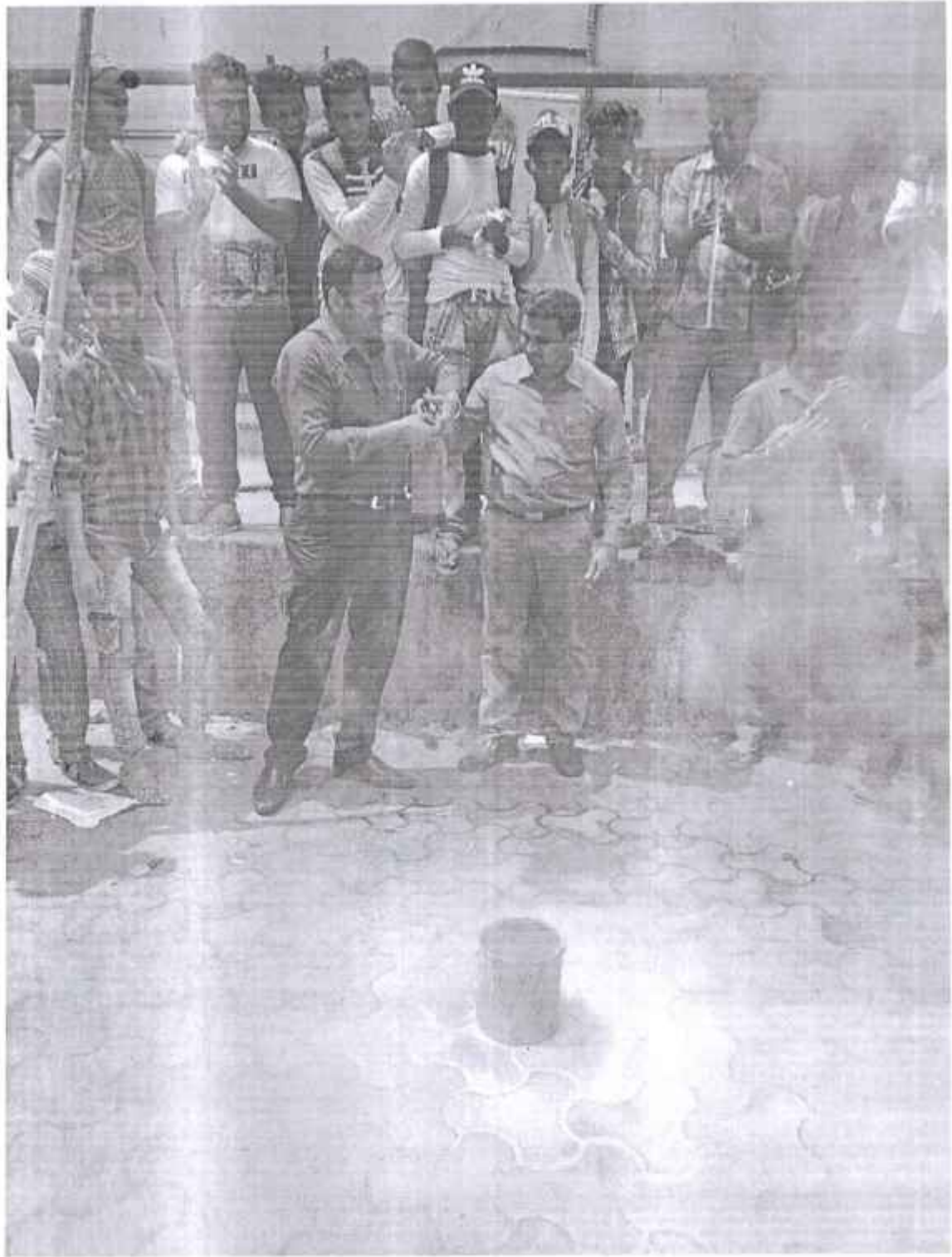
DISASTER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM on 03/10/2018

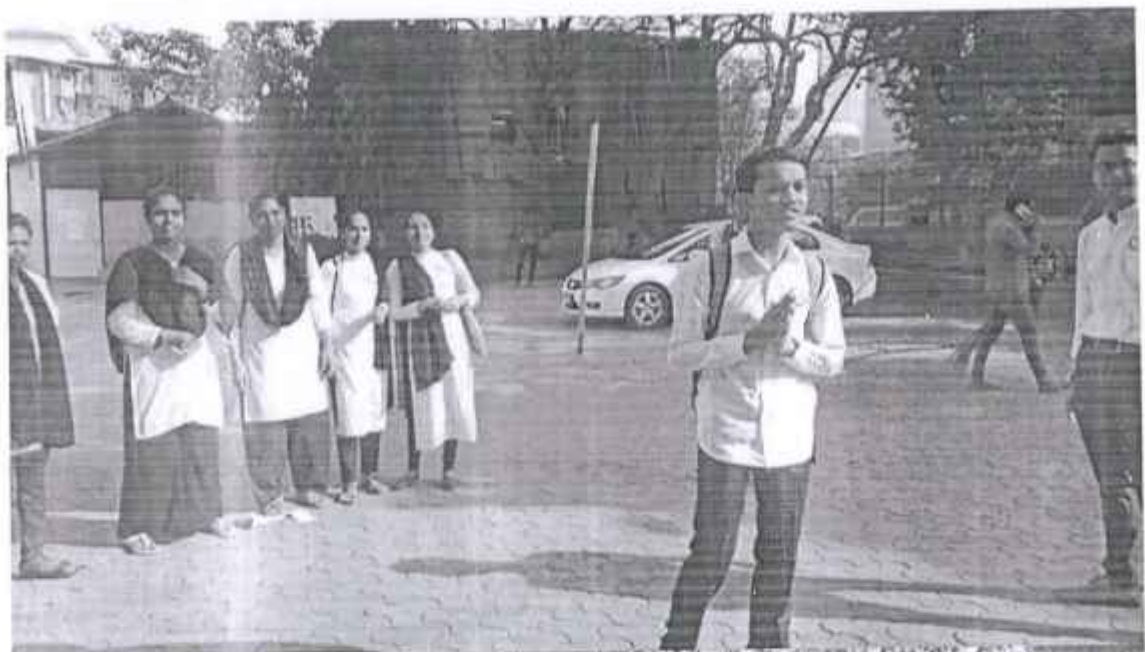

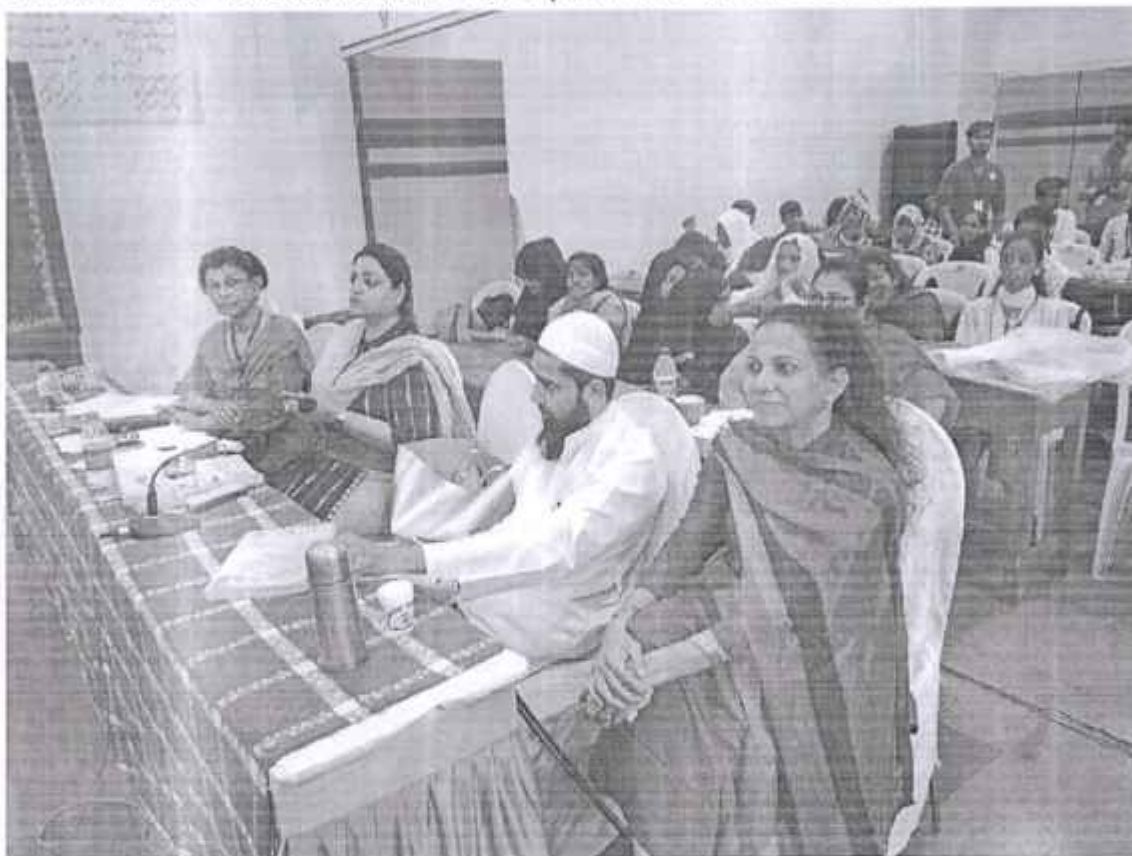




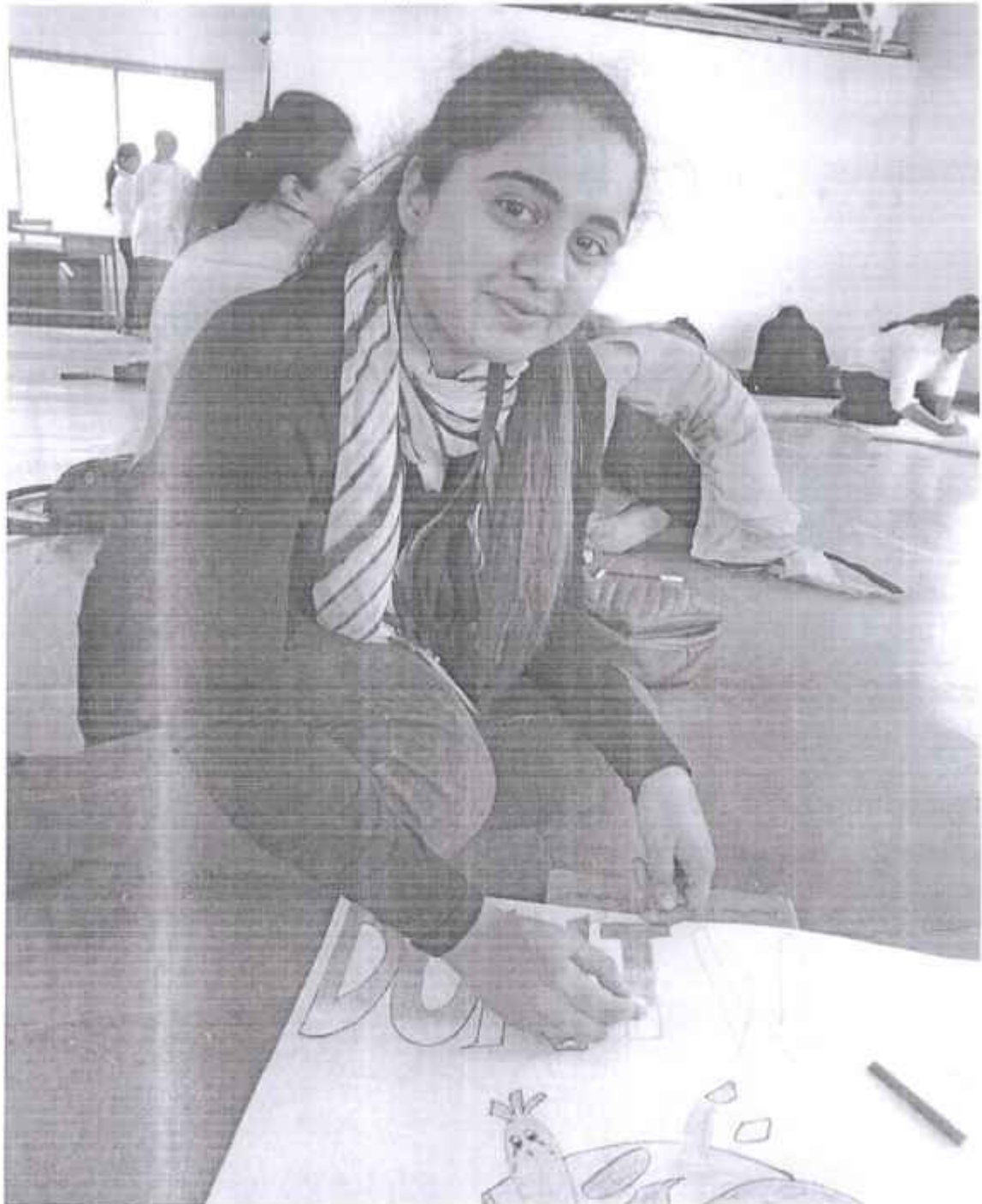
