## Activities Report of the Institution

from Aug. 2021 to Aug. 2022

### 1) Introduction of 04 New Courses:

The University of Mumbai and the JDHE, Mumbai has granted us the following new degree (graduation post graduation) courses to start in our College from the academic year 2022-23;

### 2) Career Guidance & Placement Cell:

- i. **Pre-placement Webinar** on "TCS National Qualifier Test" was conducted by the Career Guidance and Placement cell of our College for the Final year students of all courses of our College on 16<sup>th</sup> August 2021.  
TCS NQT is a nationwide test that assesses candidates' job-readiness based on their cognitive skills, job-specific skills, industry knowledge, and workplace attitude. Post taking the test, candidates can directly apply for jobs of their choice, in multiple corporate through TCS iON Job Listing Platform. Many corporates, including TCS, are planning their annual hiring through the NQT certified pool, thus increasing campus placement chances. And with better campus hiring, placement status and institutional brand value are bound to rise. TCS NQT provides value to the students through TCS placement opportunities, job assistance in other corporates, diverse product range to suit all degrees.

Ms. Namrata Sharma in her address oriented the technical outlook and extended vision about the inclusion of domain skill set with IT subject in the syllabus for long term professional career growth.
- iii. **One-Day Industrial Visit** to “Jetking – Blockchain Technology Virtual Lab, Bengaluru” situated at Dadar, Mumbai was organized for the B. Sc. IT & BCA students on 4<sup>th</sup> January 2022. The objective of the visit was to provide a real time practical exposure to the students about technical and operational trends today and coming hence forth in the field of Block chain Technology in India. This was in accordance with the prescribed curriculum of the University of Mumbai.  
 Jetking – Block Chain Virtual Lab is being used for Training, research in crypto currency, bioinformatics, virtual voting system, seismic data analysis, aeronautical engineering, scientific data processing and pharmaceutical development. This technology is a stepping stone towards building the future decentralized processing nodes in India.  
 The program was organized as desired by Ms. Yasmeen Saifullah, Executive Chairperson, Board of Higher Studies, Anjuman-I-Islam. She also motivated the students by his encouraging and wisdom words and also provided every possible support and permissions for conducting various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
