The following other matter/s were discussed with the permission of the Chair;

 IQAC Coordinator and CDC member Prof. Kirti Menghani informed that AQAR for the year 2019-20 has been prepared and submitted online to NAAC by IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell) of our College as per the NAAC requirements.

- Congratulating Prof. Kiriti Menghani on taking the charge as IQAC Coordinator, Prof. Hemanth Kumar informed that as per the norms of UGC, the role of IQAC is to enhance the quality consciousness of every aspect in the College activities.
- Prof.KirtiMenghani, Chairperson-IQAC presented the Academic calendar and the Activity Planner for the year 2021-22. IQAC coordinator informed the members that the planner has been prepared after consulting all heads of various committees. The house appreciated the efforts and approved the Calendar and Planner.
- 4. Prof. Kirti Menghani also informed that to give more exposure to industrial demand and to develop employability skills and soft skills among the students, college is approaching various professional institutions to provide proposal of program with budget. Since most of our students are coming from poor financial background, college is approaching certain corporate sector under CSR scheme to get funds for funding such programs. Thus to fill up the gap between employability skills required among students and funding for such courses College is taking initiative. Prof. Hemanth Kumar also informed about various other extra & Co curricular activities conducted like Faculty Development Programs and parent-Teacher Meeting during the period.
- 5. Morning Incharge & CDC member Prof. Mohd. Arif expressed his concern that Registrar's post is vacant. He suggested to appoint a Registrar. On this, Prof. Hemanth Kumar informed that NOC is not being issued by JDHE, Mumbai for any post during the current times due to pandemic. He also informed that the Registrar's post is generally filled on promotion of existing staff.

Mr. Farid Shaikh suggested to appoint the senior most admin staff as I/c. Registrar.

- Prof. Mohd. Arif expressed his concern over decreasing numbers of admissions in certain professional courses since last few years. One option he felt that could help attract more students is to offer high demand courses like BAF, BBI etc which would help the college to increase the total number of students admitted.
- 7. Incharge Principal Prof. Hemanth Kumar expressed that for new courses we will require additional classrooms. On this, Mr. Farid Shaikh said that we will work to get more FSI for the College building so that more classrooms can be made. He also assured his cooperation in any kind of help for betterment of the College.
- 8. Prof. Sameer Naik observed that last year due to Covid -19 many extra curricular activities could not be conducted and as such funds collected as a part of fees are lying in that particular head. He suggested that these funds can be transferred to Students Aid fund and be used to set off against outstanding fees by transferring the unused amount of fee heads like Sports, Cultural activities, etc. to Students' Aid Fund so that needy students can get their fees. The college accountant Mr. Parvez Shaikh expressed that it may not allowed as these funds are collected specifically in the relevant heads as prescribed by the University of Mumbai. Since its a good suggestion it was agreed upon by all to make necessary enquiries and efforts to check whether it can be done.

9. Prof. Hemanth Kumar informed that CDC member Dr. Smita Salunke, Asst. Professor in EVS has been awarded Major Research Project of Rs. 4.00 lacs funded by ICSSR Dr. Rajesh Bhoite, Assistant professor in Bus. Economics has also been awarded Major Research Project of approximately Rs. 11.00 lacs funded by ICSSR

Mr. Farid Shaikh appreciated the extra efforts of the entire teaching and non teaching staff as a Team in the smooth conduct of all the college activities. On the observation of I/c. Principal that the college caters to almost 3000+ students from FYJC to Phd, Mr. Farid shaikh expressed that the admission and results of this Institution is far better compared to many other Institutions. He also observed that admitting students with 35% at entry level and producing 300+ graduates specially during pandemic where getting in contact with students was so very difficult, is an extra ordinary accomplishment for Anjuman-I-Islams Akbar Peerbhoy College.

Principal Dr. Shaukat Ali presented the analysis of the Examination results of all the courses for the academic year 2021-22. He informed the house about the results as under;

HSC - 75.84%, TY.B.Com. - 88.46%, M.Com. - 88.24%

TY.BMS - 100%, TY.BMM - 100%, TY.B.Sc.(CS) - 100%, TY.B.Sc.(IT) - 100%, M.Sc.(IT) - 100%

Mrs. Yasmin Saifullah, Chairperson applauded the results and praised the efforts of all the staff of the College and congratulated them.

Prof. Sameer Naik, Chairman-Exam. Committee presented the further analysis of the Examination results. Mrs. Yasmin Saifullah praised the fact that there are more of First Class and second class students and only a few passed in pass class. She praised that there is tremendous qualitative enhancement in the results of all the courses of the College.

Prof. Sameer Naik informed the members present that due to Covid, all exams were conducted online. During this period, the Exam Committee with help of IT Cell was able to conduct the exams within a very small budget (Rs.50,000/- per session) as compared to other Colleges who invested heavily (Rs.3 to 5 Lakhs) in exam softwares.

Prof. Sameer Naik requested to make provision for an advance amount for managing daily expenses in conduct of examination and also other committees like NSS, etc.

Principal Dr. Shaukat Ali informed about the ongoing admissions for the academic year 2022-23. He informed the house that admission status is very good. Even for few courses, we took additional seats from University of Mumbai and those seats are also full.


