A Report on

Anjuman-i-Islam Akbar Peerbhoy College of Commerce and Economics celebrated Seerat-Un-Nabi (ﷺ) week (from 1st October – 7th October 2022) to promote character building and holistic growth among students in the light of Prophet Muhammad's (ﷺ) teaching.

A Naat Recitation Competition was organized jointly organized by the Seerat-Un-Nabi(ﷺ) Committee and Cultural Committee on Monday, 3rd October 2022, at room No. 1. The program was compared by Prof. Muslehuddin Shaikh and conducted by Prof. Dr. Rajesh Bhoite, Chairperson Cultural Committee. Mr. Saeb Mohimtule was invited as a judge for the event. Students from Degree section, Junior Section and Professional Section participate.

A quiz competition was organized by Professional Section on Monday, 3rd October 2022 at 1.00 PM. 43 students from BMS, BAMMC and B. Sc. IT participated. The first round was conducted online with MCQ Questions. 2 students from each stream were selected for the second round. The third and final round was played between BMS team and BAMMC Team. BMS team was the Winner for the Intra-Department Quiz competition on “Prophet(ﷺ) For All”.

A quiz competition was also organized by Junior College Section on Monday, 3rd October 2022 at 3.00 PM under the supervision of Prof. Aafreen Shaikh and Prof. Tasneem Kausar. Total 50 students participated, 25 from FYJC and 25 from SYJC. 6 students from FYJC and 2 students from SYJC scored 100% marks.

A lecture on “Prophet(ﷺ) For All” was held on 5th October 2022, 11.30 AM at the college auditorium. The Inaugural program started at 11:30 am with the recitation of the verses from the Holy Quraan by Mr. Saubaan Pistawala (TYBCA), followed by Tarana-e-Anjuman.
