

## One Week International Librarians' Development Program Report

One Week International Librarians' Development Program was Organized by Anjuman-I-Islam's Akbar Peerbhoy College of Commerce & Economics, MS Ali Road Do Taaki, Mumbai from Saturday, 25th April 2020 to Thursday, 30th April 2020. This webinar was attended by 120 Library and Information Science Professionals across the globe. There were six eminent resource persons shared their experience and knowledge.

On Saturday 25th April 2020, The Webinar was inaugurated by Prof. Mohammed Tahir, Principal, and Dr. Mohd. Faizuddin Siddiqui, Librarian, Anjuman-I-Islam's Akbar Peerbhoy College of Commerce & Economics gave introduction to participants about the One Week International LDP.

On the First Day Dr. K. Veeranjanyulu, Librarian, National Institute of Technology from Warangal, Telangana, India; spoke on the topic 'Scholarly Publication' where he explained what are the reasons for writing a research paper, different sources, steps, styles and formats, how to select the journal for publication, ethics in an academic publication, plagiarism, etc.

On Sunday 26th April 2020 Dr. Tariq Ashraf, University Librarian, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi, India; covered the topic 'Unlocking the Lockdown: Learning through Open Educational Resources (OERs)'. During this national lockdown due to the prevalent COVID-19 pandemic, it was necessary to cover such a topic that will benefit all the faculties and students. Dr. Tariq Ashraf highlighted through his University Portal the available free resources and notable among them were; DOAJ, Academic Journals, e-journals.org, Scientific Research, VLbas, MHRD initiatives, INFLIBNET and many others.

On Monday 27th April 2020 Dr. M. G. Sreekumar, Librarian, Indian Institute of Management, Kozhikode, Kerala, India; talked about 'Current Trends in Library Acquisitions: Big Deals, DDA, EBA and What Next?'. Dr. Sreekumar explained the various acquisition models for print and non-print material required for the library. The topic was unique and most of the participants were unaware of the existence of such models.

On Tuesday 28th April 2020 Dr. Akhtar Parvez, University Librarian, Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU), Hyderabad, Telangana, India; shared his library's experience on the topic 'Stock Verification: A Model for Academic Libraries'. Dr. Parvez has developed this unique and innovative way of carrying stock verification work and I do not hesitate to recommend its implementation in academic libraries.

On Wednesday 29th April 2020 Mr. Shakil Ahmad, Lecturer & Technical Services Librarian, Imam Abdulrahman Bin Faisal University, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia; discussed on the topic 'Bibliometric Tools (Biblioshiny, Histcite and VOS Viewer) Smart Searching on Internet (Google Scholar, CORE, OER). The session was informative and all the participants appreciated the presentation.

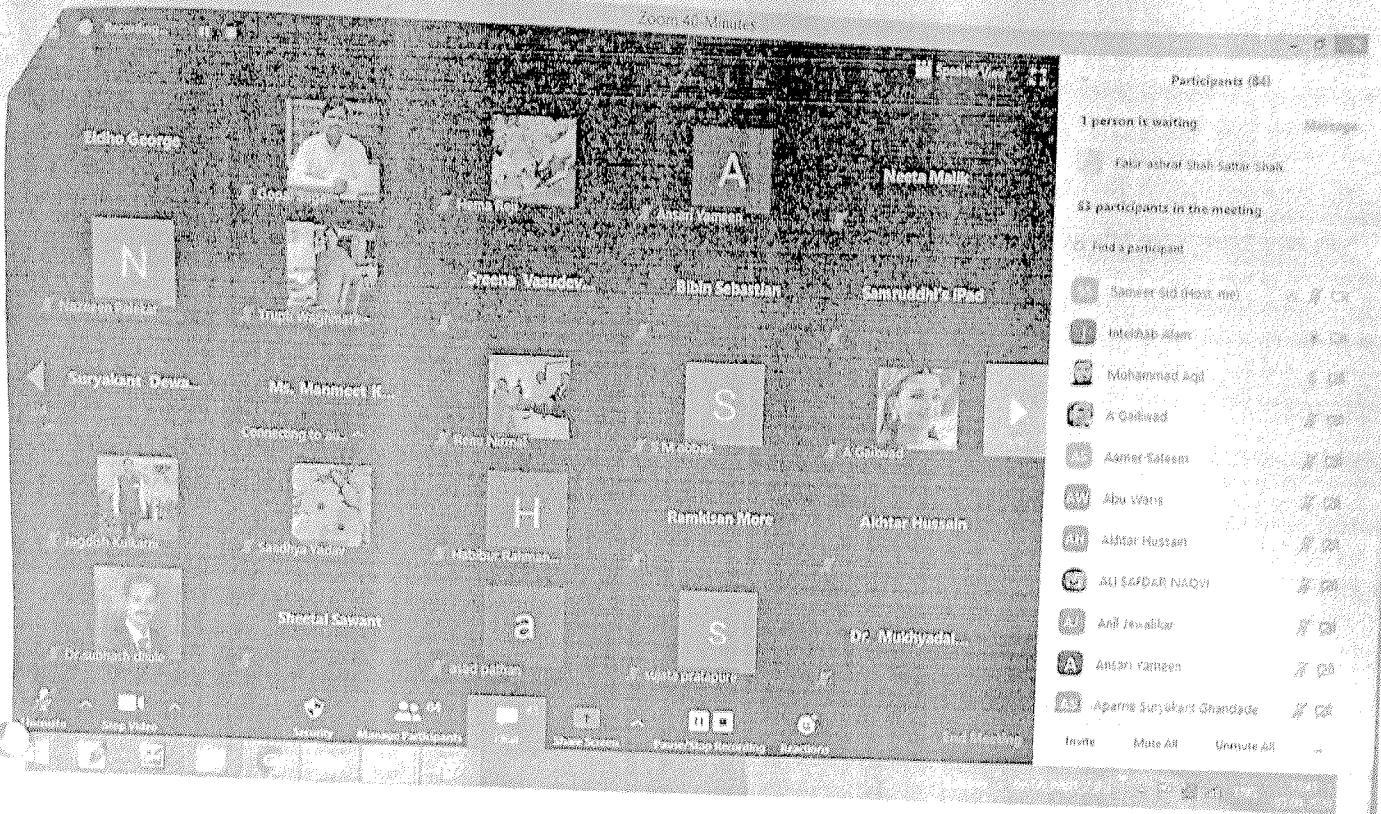
