All the students of B. Com., B. Sc. IT, B. Sc. CS,BMS and BAMMC were in attendance.

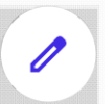

At the end the vote of thanks was given and a feedback was collected from students to assess information they got through this session



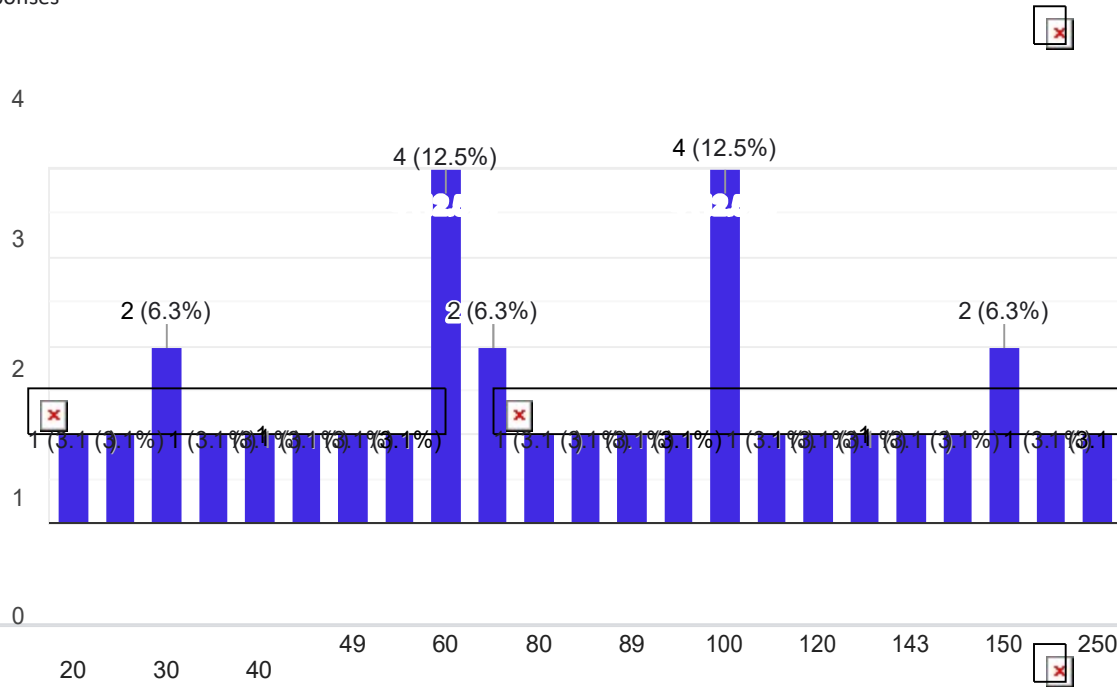
Program started by enlightening students with technical terms used in cyber security.. He explained the hierarchy to be maintained in cyber security..

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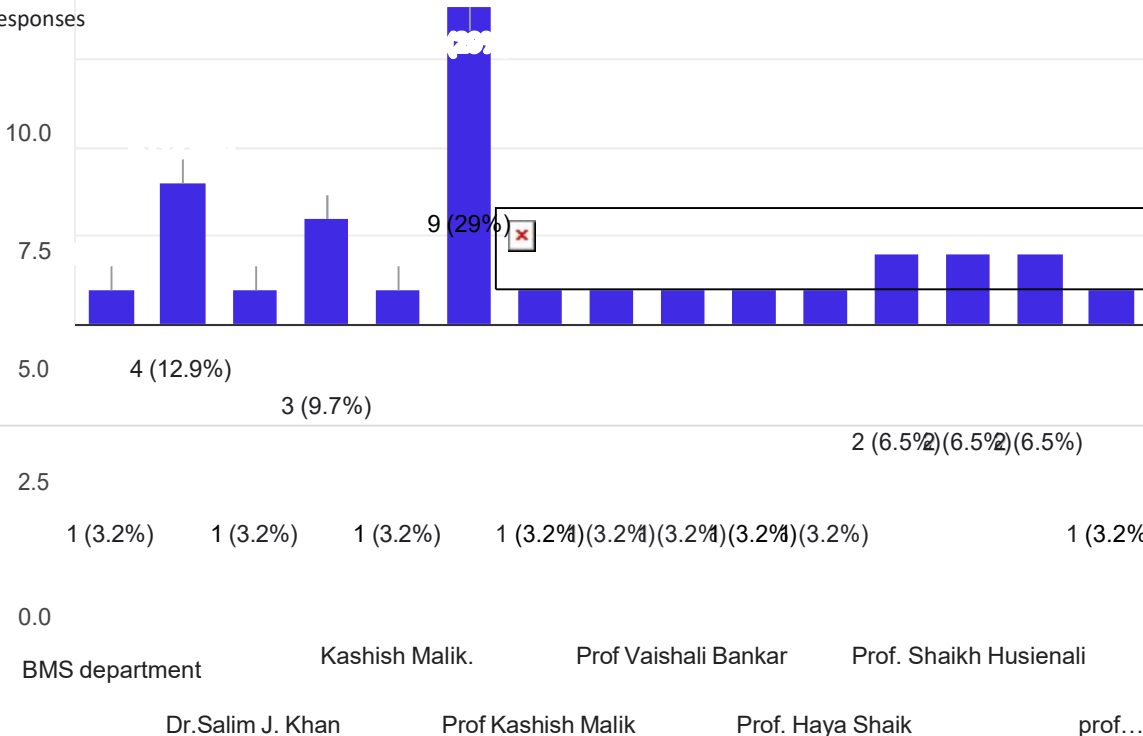

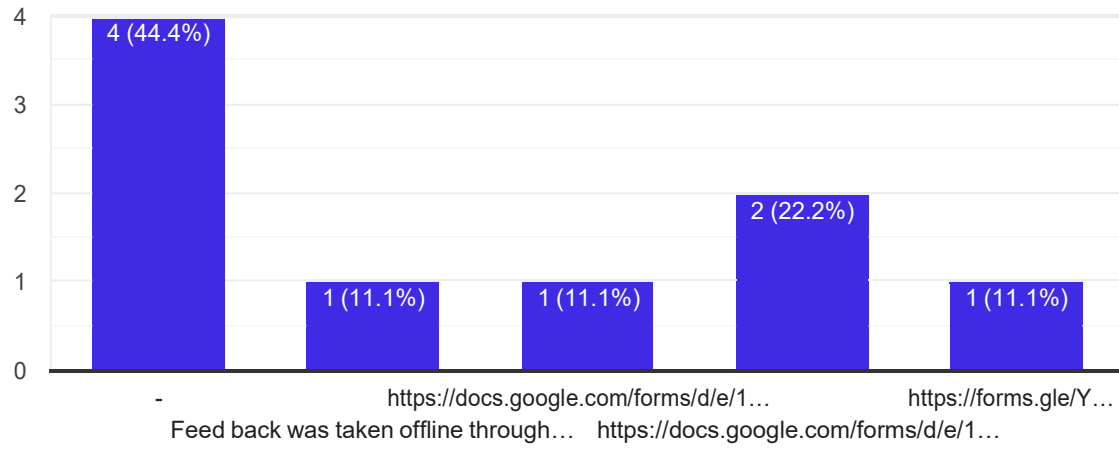
