

It was originally named as Anjuman College of Commerce & Economics, but in the year 1975 it was dedicated to the memory of late Mr. Akbar Peerbhoy, a noted barrister, philanthropist, educationist and founder of the college. It is now known as Anjuman-i-Islam's Akbar Peerbhoy College of Commerce & Economics. This year the college has completed 55 years of its useful and beneficial existence. The college is permanently affiliated to the University of Mumbai for the teaching courses of studies upto B.Com Degree Examination (Three-year integrated B.Com Degree course). The college has also started the Degree Courses of Bachelor in Management Studies (BMS), Bachelor of Science in Information Technology B.Sc.(IT), B.Sc. (Computer Science) and Bachelor in Mass Media (BMM). In addition, the College also conducts certificate courses in Computer Programming (Software) and Diploma in Business Management. The College conducts M.Com Classes and has started M.Sc. (I.T.) from June 2007. The College has lush Green Campus. The College has been recognised as Ph. D. Research Centre since 2014-15 by University of Mumbai.

The college is conveniently located on Maulana Shaukat Ali Road, Mumbai 400008, midway between J.J. Hospital Junction and Grant Road Railway Station. It can also be reached by B.E.S.T. buses plying on route No. 135 between Mazgaon Dock and August Kranti Maidan, via J.J.Hospital and Grant Road Railway Station. The academic year 2019-20 dawned with an outstanding and extremely good message. The results have made outstanding features visible across the Board and University. Honestly a good number of students secured distinctions and first classes in S.Y.J.C., T.Y. B.Com, T.Y.BMS, T.Y. B.Sc (CS), T.Y. B.Sc (IT) and M.Com course. In T.Y. B.Com, the pass percentage of our College is 94.62%. There is a quantitative as well as qualitative improvement in T.Y. B.Com results. Our H.S.C. results enhanced to 75.16% as against 69.32% last year. Our T.Y. BMS Sem VI result is 100%. Our TYBAMMC result



is 100%, B.Sc. (Comp. Sc.) result is 100% and T.Y.B.Sc.(IT) Sem VI results 100%, M. Sc (IT) Sem IV results 100% and M. Com result is 85,96%. Many faculty members of the College have contributed enormously to various reseach papers which have been presented and published in state, national and international seminars, conferences and symposiums. The College Annual function 'Jashn-e-Anjuman 2019-20' is being held from 5th February 2020. It comprised of more than 20 events including indoor competitions, stage events. Our teachers and students took part in the same in large quantity. In Inter-Collegiate events, students from different Colleges across Mumbai, Pune and Bhiwandi also participated. Inter-Collegiate Bait-Bazi Competition held on 5th February 2020, Indoor and Stage Events held on 6th February 2020, InterCollegiate 'JAM' held on 10th February 2020 - of B.M.M. Dept. A State Level Workshop on Library Digitization was organized in association with VIKMANS, New Delhi on 20 th Dec. 2019. 67 Librarians from different Colleges, Institutes and Government sector (like Mumbai High Court) participated from all over Mumbai, Raigad and other districts of the state. Mr. Manish Chhabra, Director VIKMANS and team gave PowerPoint presentation and gave hands-on training to all the participants, followed by Question and Answers session. It was informative for all the participants. Dept. of Lifelong Learning and Extension unit of our College organized an interactive session on "Softs Skills and Personality Development" on 03-02-2020. Prof. Sambhaji Sirsath from Terna College of Engineering was the Resource Person, Under National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language (NCPUL) Ministry of Human Resource Development, our college has one year diploma in functional Urdu language and Two years diploma in functional Arabic language. In this, we enrolled 92 students in Urdu and 96 in Arabic languages for the academic year 2019-20. #### MESSAGE FROM THE DESK OF EDITOR

Dr. Syed Mohd Abbas Rizvi

Professor Ahmed Ali: A Forgotten Literary Star

When the world was deeply wounded by the two World Wars, which was, the result of the capitalistic tendencies of European nations, it stirred a worldwide reaction against the capitalistic system of government. The world became conscious of the fact that there is an unjust and cruel exploitation of the workers and farmers through whom the capitalist mint their money and in return give almost nothing to the labourer. This gave birth to a new



economic system in which capital was sought to be disbursed in proportion to man's labour. This was technically known as communism, which assumed a strong force and became a campaign against capitalism. Pioneered by German and Russian thinkers like Marx and Lenin, it made inroads into a number of countries. The entire world was divided into two blocks, namely, the capitalist and the communist. The philosophy and thought of communism made a deep impression upon the conscience of humanity and set into motion a literary wave known as the Progressive writings. All the genre of literature viz...poetry, drama and novel became the instruments of propagation of progressive thoughts. The dream to be realized was to remove social classes and establish classless society. India being in the grip of exploitation by the Raja and Maharaja as well as the Zamindars produced by the British capitalism, the communistic ideas quickly made their way into the hearts of the masses. Syed Sajjad Zaheer, Premchand, Syed Ajaz Huasain, Syed Ehtesham Husain Rizvi, Josh, Faiz, Mulk Raj Anand, Raghupati Sahai 'Firaq', Surva Kant Tripathi 'Nirala', Ali Sardar Jafri, Krish Chander, Minto, Rajendra Singh 'Bedi' Mahadevi Verma and Rasheed Jahan etc. emerged as a group to use literature as a vehicle to uphold progressive ideology. The rogressive writers made a club of their own holding meetings and encouraging to produce literary works of strong anti-capitalistic ethos. Ahmed Ali was one of the most active member of this literary movement who contributed to it, by writing novels, short stories and a few poems. It is morally appropriate to remember him and appreciate his works and their merit in the backdrop of political and literary currents of that time. Professor Ahmed Ali was born in 1910 at Delhi, and educated at Aligarh Muslim University and Lucknow University holding first position in both B.A. (Hons) and M.A. in English. He taught at leading Indian universities including Lucknow and Allahabad from 1932 to 1936 and joined the Bengal Senior Education as a professor and head of the English department at the Presidency College, Calcutta (1944-47), Professor Ahmed Ali was also BBC's representative and director to India during 1942 to 1944. In 1947, he went to China as the British Council visiting professor of English at the National Central University at Nounkind. There, he learnt Chinese and translated from Chinese poems and gathered material for his book "Muslim China". In China, his house became a gathering of friends. China became his second home. A year later India was divided and he came from China to Karachi 1948, becoming director of foreign publicity, government of Pakistan. He joined the Pakistan foreign services at the insistence of Mr. Liagat Ali Khan and the first file, he read was marked "China" but was blank. He was successfully established diplomatic relation with the people of China in a record time and joined the Pakistan Embassy in Beijing in 1950 and the Embassy in Morocco in 1958 with Prime Minister Shahid Sahervardi. He visited China again in 1956. Professor Ahmed Ali started his literary career at a very young age and became a member of the All India Progressive Writers Movement and Association with the publication of "Angaray" in 1932, a collection of short stories by four young friends.

Shortly afterward, Ahmed Ali and Mahmood-uz-Zafar announced the formation of "League of Progressive Authors" which was later to expand and become the All India Progressive Writers Association. Ahmed Ali presented his papers "aaj ka taraqqi pasand nazaria", in its inaugural conference in 1936. A pioneer of the modern Urdu short story, Ahmed Ali's works include collection of short stories: Sholey (1934), Hamari Gali (1940), Qaidkhana (1942) and Maut se Pahle (1943). Ahmed Ali achieved international fame with his novel "Twilight in Delhi" which was first published by the Hogarth Press in London in 1940. It was widely acclaimed by critics and hailed in India as a major literary event and took the English speaking world by storm. It has since then acquired the position of a legend. The leading critic Maurice Collis, in Time and Tide, of London wrote:

It may well be that we may not understand India until it is explained how by Indian novelist of the first ability as it was that; we understand nothing of Russia before we read Tolstoy, Turge Hev and others. Ali may well be the vanguard of such a literary movements.

This judgment was reached by the Oxford history of India 1958, when it said in a reference to Ahmed Ali, Mulk Raj Anand, and R. K. Narayanan:

It can be said that they have taken to annex from E. M. Forster and Edward Thomson the task of interpreting modern India to itself and the world.

"Twilight in Delhi" has been translated into many languages including French, Spanish and Italian. Its exemplary Urdu translation 'Dilli ki Sham' (1963) by Ahmed Ali's talented wife, Bilquees Jahan in the opinion of the same critics restored the natural language to book, but those who read the translation said it could not have been written in English, while those who had read it in the original English said it was untranslatable. This curious controversy was put to end by the American critic Dr. David O Anderson, when he said:

The novel transcends language as any substantial work of art ultimately must do.

Ahmed Ali's other works include two novels "Ocean of Night" (1964) and "Rats and Diplomats" (1985), "The Prison House" (1985), "Purple Gold Moment" are selected poems, Mr. Eliots Penny's words of the 'Muslim China', 'Ghalib's selected poems'.

The problem of style and technique in 'Ghalib' and 'The Claiming Earth'. Professor Ahmed Ali translated from Urdu, Persian, Indonasian, Chinese and Arabic. His translation of classical Urdu poetry the 'Golden Tradition' (Columbia University Press; 1973), makes and important contribution to the study of comparative literature and surveys in depth the literary and philosophical background of 18th and 19th century.

Al-Quran, a contemporary translation (Princeton University Press, Oxford University Press), is Professor Ahmed Ali's most outstanding contribution in the field of translation, approved by eminent Islamic Scholars. It has come to be recognized as the best of the existing translations of the Holy Quran. In the words of Dr. F. E. Petend of the New York University:

"Ahmed Ali's work is clear, direct and elegant – a combination of stylistic virtues almost never found in translation of Quran. His is the best, I have read."

Ahmed Ali was a distinguished visiting professor of the universities at Michigan State University in 1975, Fulbright visiting professor of History at Western Kentucy University and Fulbright visiting professor of English at Southern Illinois University in 1978-79. He was made honorary citizen by the State of Nabvask in 1979 which later conferred on him an honourary degree of Doctor of Literature. In 1933, this distinguished gentle man of refined tastes and manners, Professor Ahmed Ali had developed a deep interest in Sufism and a passion for Ghalib. His writings voice concern over the decay of the Muslims and injustices of colonial powers. Proficient in several languages including French, Chinese, Persian and Quranic Arabic, he captivated audiences by his eloquent speeches and expressions. Steeped in tradition but progressive at heart, he was equally at home in the East and the West. Professor Ahmed Ali had travelled widely and was an arid collector of Chinese Procakisin and paintings, Gurudhinea art and other antiques. He rubbed shoulders with kings and dignitaries and among his circles were E. M. Forster, George Orwell, Virginia Woolf and the Bloomsbury group, H. M. Silvian, Tien Chau, Sarojini Naidu, Lakchmi Pandit, Raja Rao, Kunwar Natwar Singh and Sohrab Wardy family. Mohsin Abdul Ali and others from Aligarh were his friends to the end.

Professor Ahmed Ali's career expands the better of both continuents and he put us in touch with both our past and our present. His renderings of South Asia, SouthEast

Asia and Far East established links which were not yet known and are remembered respectfully. His creative writing invites interest and is enduring contribution to international letters. He was elected the founding-fellow of Pakistan Academy of Letters in 1979 and was awarded the "Sitara-e-Imtiaz" in 1980 in recognition of his contribution to letters and nation. He died in Karachi on 14th January 1994. As the capitalistic tendencies are fast growing in this age of Consumerism and the economic divide between the haves and have not is widening and reasserting in a most complex and most fatal ways taking the moneyed class to crimes and the poor to suicide, it is befitting to remember the progressive writers like Ahmed Ali again. His small literary output has enough potential to make us visualize the political, colonial and cultural onslaught of the West on the East and Muslim tradition. The modern global crisis in areas of social justice and moral order is the offshoot of the same Western Onslaught.

In a classroom fall of exuberant five year olds, the teacher removes bulky furniture to make room for large. Muscle activities like black building and water play, A teacher raises a couple of tables on wooden blocks so a child using a wheelchair can write comfortable and have some choice about where to. For Hyr old, who crave autonomy and interaction with peers, a teachers arranges desks in dusters and also provide tables and floor pillows so students can choose among places to sit when working independently. A child with attentional difficulties can choose to work in a teacher created "Corner office "Consisting of a small table chair, and table top screens fashioned from Manila file folders. Open inheriting a classroom previously used by fourth graders a second grade teacher provides plastic cubes for footrest do children can sit more. Comfortably in too big chairs.
